

## DEFINITION OF MEMBERSHIP STATUS

The Organization consists of an unlimited number of members who are connected to the members or directly to the Organization.

Any member may terminate their membership at any time by giving a written notice to the member or the Organization.

The member may be expelled for any reason deemed valid and the decision of the Board of Directors will be final.

The member has neither the right to receive a notice of summons to meetings, nor the right to be present at these meetings and the right to participate in the deliberations of the Organization.

The member may represent the member at the various meetings that the Organization convenes and enjoy the rights granted to him by statute.

### **Membership period, rights and contribution.**

A member is considered as such when he registers and paid his membership fee and contributions. The member therefore benefits after a probationary period of **90 days** from the date of membership (member aged 69 and under) or **181 days** from registration (member aged 70 and over)

The member must pay a contribution per death. He is informed of the status of his contributions by the member or the Organization. No payment or contribution is required as long as there are no deaths within the Organization.

### **Members' rights and privileges**

Each member is entitled to a service that is dignified and respectful funeral. The remains can be repatriated to the country of origin or to any other desired location.

The member has the right to leave a member or to change groups while retaining his status as a former member. A member may represent his community (country of origin) within the Board if it is proven that his community has the minimum required of scattered registrants to be a member, although these members do not constitute a group or association.

**Loss of membership**

The member is no longer a member of the Organization when the member to whom he is attached loses his membership status. However, the member is free to register alone or to join another group or to take over the management of the account in which he was registered, should the holder dies.

**Transfer of members or change of group**

A member is free to leave one member for another as long as he respects the rules governing the transfer. The Board may, depending on the circumstances, set administrative costs if this requires additional resources.

**Using the godson link**

Members who wish to increase the number of members can use the girl link to do so. It has to copy and share. The member has no right to the account of the generated godchild, he has no access to the information of the godson and he is not responsible for the contributions.
